Saturday 14th January 2017.

Welcome to this event organised by South Hams Motor Club which we hope will be useful for competitors for the 2017 season.

The landowner Lloyd Stevens has kindly agreed the use of his land for practise/driver training.

Are you rubbish at starting? Too many revs or keep on stalling at that vital moment?

Can't fathom how to correct understeer or oversteer?

Power slides and Scandinavian flicks or even the basic clutch control then this can be the ideal place to learn.

We have the full use of the venue between 10am and 3:30pm for you to do as you choose.

Hopefully, this will give you the boost to your confidence for the season ahead, whether it's rallying, sprinting, autocross or gymkhanas.

It is entirely a practise/training event organised for the sole purpose of enabling drivers to gain experience of their vehicles.

There is **NO** element of competition.

There will be **NO awards**.

Times will not be recorded.

Cars will **NOT** be started simultaneously.

After the long queues and waits at signing on previous years, we are asking for all entries to be made online via shmc.co.uk where you can pay via paypal. This should mean that we can get started on time, ensuring a full day.

Memberships can also be completed on line, and you will have to make sure you leave enough time to allow your membership card to be processed and posted out to you as you will have to show it on the day.

We expect Subaru WRC Spares, Southwest Motorsport and AC Services all to be present on the day carrying a selection of their wares.

ARTICLE 1 - ANNOUNCEMENT

1.1 South Hams Motor Club will organise and promote a driver's training day, based at Upottery Airfield otherwise known as Smeatharpe on **Saturday 14th January 2017**, on the Devon/Somerset border.

ARTICLE 2 – Jurisdiction

2.1 The event will be held under these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions, which the organising club may issue for the event.

ARTICLE 3 – Authorisation

3.1 Public Liability Insurance has been applied for the value of £5 million.

ARTICLE 4 – Eligibility

4.1 The event is open to fully elected members of South Hams Motor Club who must hold a valid DVLA driving licence.

4.2 Competitors are reminded of the requirement to produce Club Membership cards at Documentation.

4.3 All vehicles MUST POSSESS A VALID mot Certificate (if applicable) and an MSA Log Book (if applicable)

4.4 Vehicles will not be required to be taxed or insured for the public highway.

4.5 Passengers will be allowed and will need to produce a valid Club membership card as per 4.1.

4.6 Unders-18s are allowed to drive or be a passenger but if driving they and their adult appropriate passenger MUST hold a MSA competition driving licence.

ARTICLE 5 – Timetable

5.2 The venue is now subject to strict laws imposed by the local authority that allow motorsport events and car engines to be run between 09:01am and 4:00pm ONLY.

ARTICLE 6 – Vehicle Eligibility

6.1 All vehicles must comply with MSA Regulations J Competitors: Vehicles

6.2 The organisers reserve the right to reject any vehicle they deem not fit to take part.

ARTICLE 7 – Entries

7.1 Entries for the event will open on the publication of these regulations and close on 7th January 2017.

7.2 The organisers reserve the right to accept entries after this date should the maximum number not be reached.

7.3 The entry fee is **£50 per Driver, £10 per Passenger plus** Insurance which is compulsory and costs **£25:00 per car**

7.4 All entries should be made on-line via SHMC.CO.UK and paid for using Paypal

7.5 Incomplete details may be deemed as not accepted.

7.7 Entries cancelled by email up to and including 8th January 2107 will be refunded in **FULL**.

7.8 Entry fees will not be refunded to any entry that fails to start or meet the Documentation requirements.

7.9 Entries will be on a first come first serve basis which shall be allocated at the discretion of the organisers.

7.10 The **MAXIMUM** number of starters for the event is 50

7.11 The **MINIMUM** entry for the event is 30.

7.12 Should 7.11 not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the event.

8.1 The event will take place on private land at Smeatharpe aerodrome otherwise known as Upton Airfield.

8.5 Times may be recorded but not published.

13.2 All spillage must be contained and removed from the site.

13.4 There will NOT be a designated re-fuelling area.

13.5 Petrol & Water will NOT be available at the Service Area.

13.6 Hot food & drink will be available throughout the day at the Service Area.
