Following the success of online entry and payments at previous events, we are asking for all entries (and passengers) to be made online via shmc.co.uk where you can pay via PayPal. Additionally, you will Sign-on in advance of the event.

Memberships can also be completed online with your entry, and you will have to make sure you leave enough time to allow your membership card to be processed and posted out to you as you may have to show it on the day.

This should mean that we can get started on time, ensuring a full day.

ARTICLE 1 – ANNOUNCEMENT

1.1 South Hams Motor Club will organise and promote a driver's training day, based at Upottery Airfield otherwise known as Smeatharpe (EX14 9RF) on **Saturday 22nd January 2022**, on the Devon/Somerset border.

ARTICLE 2 – Jurisdiction

2.1 The event will be held under these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions, which the organising club may issue for the event.

ARTICLE 3 – Authorisation

3.1 Public Liability Insurance has been applied for the value of £5 million.

ARTICLE 4 – Eligibility

- 4.1 The event is open to fully elected members of South Hams Motor Club who must hold a valid DVLA driving licence.
- 4.2 Drivers are reminded of the requirement to produce Club Membership cards at Signing-on (online) and at the event, if asked.
- 4.3 All vehicles MUST POSSESS A VALID mot Certificate (if applicable) and a Motorsport UK Log Book (if applicable).
- 4.4 Vehicles will not be required to be taxed or insured for the public highway.
- 4.5 Passengers will be allowed and will need to produce a valid Club membership card as per 4.1. All passengers are to pay on-line at www.shmc.co.uk. This can be done from 8th January and up to and including at the event.
- 4.6 Participants must supply and wear full overalls and helmet.
- 4.7 All entrants to be aged 18 or over.

ARTICLE 5 – Timetable

5.1 The timetable for entries and the event is as follows:

Entries Close: 18th January 2022

Signing-on: Open on-line from 8th January to 21st January

5.2 The venue is now subject to strict laws imposed by the local authority that allow motorsport events and car engines to be run between 09:01am and 4:00pm ONLY.

ARTICLE 6 – Vehicle Eligibility

- 6.1 All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK Regulations J Competitors: Vehicles
- 6.2 All vehicles should carry a tow rope.
- 6.3 The organisers reserve the right to reject any vehicle they deem not fit to take part.

ARTICLE 7 – Entries

- 7.1 Entries for the event will open on 3rd December (20:00hrs) and close on 18th January 2022.
- 7.2 The organisers reserve the right to accept entries after this date should the maximum number not be reached.
- 7.3 The entry fee is £85 per Driver and Car. This includes insurance which is compulsory and costs £25.00 per car. £10 per Passenger. Additional drivers in the same car are allowed at an extra £60 per driver.
- 7.4 All entries should be made at **SHMC.CO.UK** Credit / debit cards via PayPal
- 7.5 Incomplete details may be deemed as not accepted.

- 7.7 Entries cancelled by email up to and including 18th January 2022 will be refunded in **FULL**.
- 7.8 Entry fees will not be refunded to any entry that fails to start or meet the Documentation requirements.
- 7.9 Entries will be on a first come first serve basis which shall be allocated at the discretion of the organisers.
- 7.10 The **MAXIMUM** number of starters for the event is 50
- 7.11 The **MINIMUM** entry for the event is 30.
- 7.12 Should 7.11 not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the event.

- 8.1 The event will take place on private land at Smeatharpe aerodrome otherwise known as Upottery Airfield.

- 8.6 Cars will NOT be started simultaneously.

ARTICLE 13 – Health & Safety

Notes for Service Area Best Practice will be issued at signing on and **ALL** Service Personnel are required to comply with the conditions within.

- 13.1 All servicing must be carried out on a **Tarpaulin ground sheet**.
- 13.2 All spillages must be contained and removed from the site.
- 13.4 There will NOT be a designated re-fuelling area.
- 13.5 Petrol & Water will NOT be available at the Service Area.
- 13.6 Hot food & drink will be available throughout the day at the Service Area.

ARTICLE 14 - COVID-19

- 19.1 Social Distancing will be observed where possible
- 19.2 The event will be run in a COVID-19 aware manner to the latest UK Government and Motorsport UK guidelines.
- 19.3 All pre and post event paperwork will be electronic where possible
- 19.4 Fees are by Paypal.
- 19.5 Entrants should withdraw their entry if they have experienced any COVID-19 symptoms within 10 days prior to the event
