The middle gate is the ONLY way into the venue for Test Day, if you are late please report to the Radio Car where the radio operator will stop proceedings so you can enter!!

Please note within a 3 miles radius of the venue there is normally a police manned speed camera located either in the village of Smeatharpe or on the main road You have been warned.

There will be a burger van present.

As long as South West Tool Hire delivers them, we will also have some toilets.

Westcountry Rescue will be in attendance - some of the unsung heroes of the motorsport world, so please make sure you go and say thank you to them – as without them you wouldn't have days like this or motorsport in general.

Convoy run/marshals in place	09:45 ish!
1st car on track	10:00am or as near
Last car on track	15:00

Format:

Whatever you want!!!

Cars will line up and set off on suitable gaps in batches of up to 15 – cars may be held if the track gets 'busy'.

Once on the track you may complete up to 2 laps then you will be waved in by a marshal, just re-join the queue or proceed to the service area.

Once on the track please follow prescribed course.

If you break down – contact nearest marshal post to arrange recovery, [please bring a tow rope/strap to aid recovery.](#)

If you see a stationary red flag – car broken down stopped – please avoid.

If you see a waved red flag – STOP immediately – accident or danger ahead.

No runs will be timed – that's up to you!!

NOTE - ALL Drivers and Passengers MUST be a member of South Hams Motor Club

ALL participants must supply and wear full overalls and helmet.

Bales and other items may be used to define the route. Drivers responsible for the destruction of bales or similar items will be expected to pay for a **replacement bale at a cost of £50.**

Kindly note: The venue is subject to strict laws imposed by the local authority that allow motorsport events and car engines to be run between 09:01am and 4:00pm ONLY.

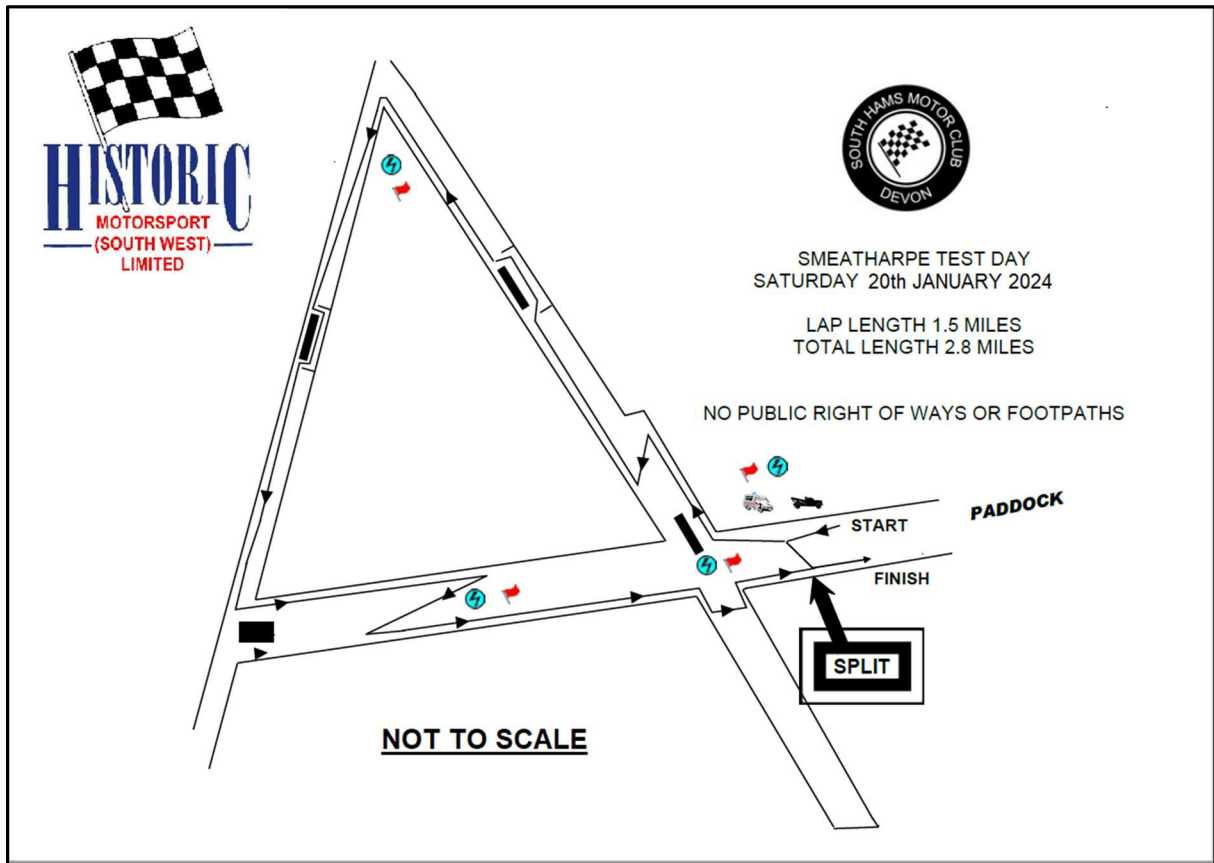
If you want to join the club you can do so at the website (£18 / £23 credit/debit card/ PayPal) or at the event £18 each / £23 household membership cash only please.

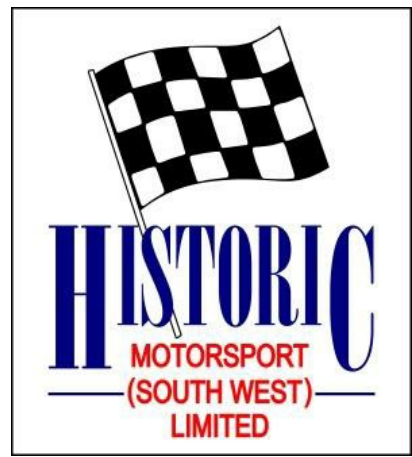


The layout is subject to change – there is a sighting lap / convoy after the Driver's briefing at approx. 0945hrs
