The Primrose Rally

11th and 12th January 2025.

Thank you for your entry. We have worked at bringing a slick event we hope you have an enjoyable experience and event with us.

For this event we have a new venue for the start/finish, the Miners Arms. We have been welcomed by the team here and would like to use the venue in the future so please keep vehicle noise to an absolute minimum when leaving on Saturday night and especially on returning.

On arrival proceed to the trailer park as per the enclosed map and unload your car. Then proceed to noise test and scrutineering as per the enclosed map.

When you are finished at scrutineering go to the Miners Arms documentation, where you will collect your rally plates in your Rally Pack, which will have to be on the vehicle before you enter MTC0.

We recommend that crews attend documentation as early as you can to allow as much time as possible to become familiar with the contents of the pack.

There will be DSO's on route and special attention will be given to driving standards. We ask for your continued cooperation to safeguard future use of these areas, by adhering to the lower speed limits we have applied.

Competitors are reminded of Section 170 of the Road Traffic Act 1988 and Rule 286 of the Highway Code. Any injury incidents must be reported to the Police Authority.

Please find enclosed changes to the SRs (as bulletin 1), map for Scrutineering, Noise, and HQ. Also attached is a provisional entry list.

Any changes will be minimal, so please proceed through Environmental and Scrutineering with the number from the attached list. Start Times will be posted on the Notice Board.

Amendments to the SRs:

4. Competitor Eligibility - The Event is open to:

b. *add* Southsea MC, HOVAC and Brecon.

5. Vehicle Eligibility

Tyres are free for competitor's choice, subject to Ch 8 App 4 Art *2-3.1c inclusive*, with the reminder the event is run on the public highway and therefore tyres should be legal and comply with the Road Traffic Act at all times, which is the competitor's responsibility.

All vehicles must comply with Motorsport UK National Competition Rules Ch 13 App 1 Art 7, Ch 13 App 3 Art *4 g - i*, Ch 13 App 15 Art *2-2.10*, Ch 13 App 15 Art *3.8*, Ch 13 App 15 Art *4-4.4*. Each competing vehicle is required to carry a Small Spill kit, which must be present at scrutiny for inspection. In accordance with Ch 13 App 3 Art *12.1c* NO intercoms are to be used on the event except for those with Motorsport UK certificate of medical dispensation which must be presented at signing on, but mobile phones may be carried in competing cars for emergency purposes only.

Please can all competitors treat Hemerdon and the pub car park as a very quiet and keep noise to an absolute minimum.

Crews Briefing at Signing On: *20:45*. All crew members to attend. *South Western Championship 2024 awards and SHMC/JDM loyalty scheme draw will be carried out at the start of the driver's briefing.*

MTC0: Rally HQ Saturday 11th January *21:31*.

8. Types of Section

- Standard (Ch 13 App 4 Art 4)

- Neutral (Ch 13 App 4 Art 5) (Must be done without any Auxiliary lighting, except permitted by law in conditions of poor visibility)
- Regularity (Ch 13 App 4 Art 6)

11. Route, Route Information and Starting Order

The rally is contained on OS map 201 and 202 1:50000 latest edition and contains 4.5 miles of whites, the route information will be issued at MTC0 and it will contain all the information needed for crews to comply with Ch 13 App 2 Art 4.1c.

13. Controls and Control Procedure

For sections MTC1 to ITC10 and MTC35 to LRTC44 there will be *20 minutes 59 seconds lateness*.

Any RC or unmanned control will have a code board present, which must be authenticated visually by the marshal at the next manned control (Not DSO). (Ch 13 App 5 Art 4.3 and Art 5.4)

14. Judges of Fact and Driving Standards Observers

Judges of Fact will be appointed and listed on the Official Notice board to adjudicate on Ch 13 App 3 Art 3.

Driving Standards Observers will be appointed and listed on the Official Notice board to adjudicate on Ch 13 App 3 Art 3.7 and 3.8.

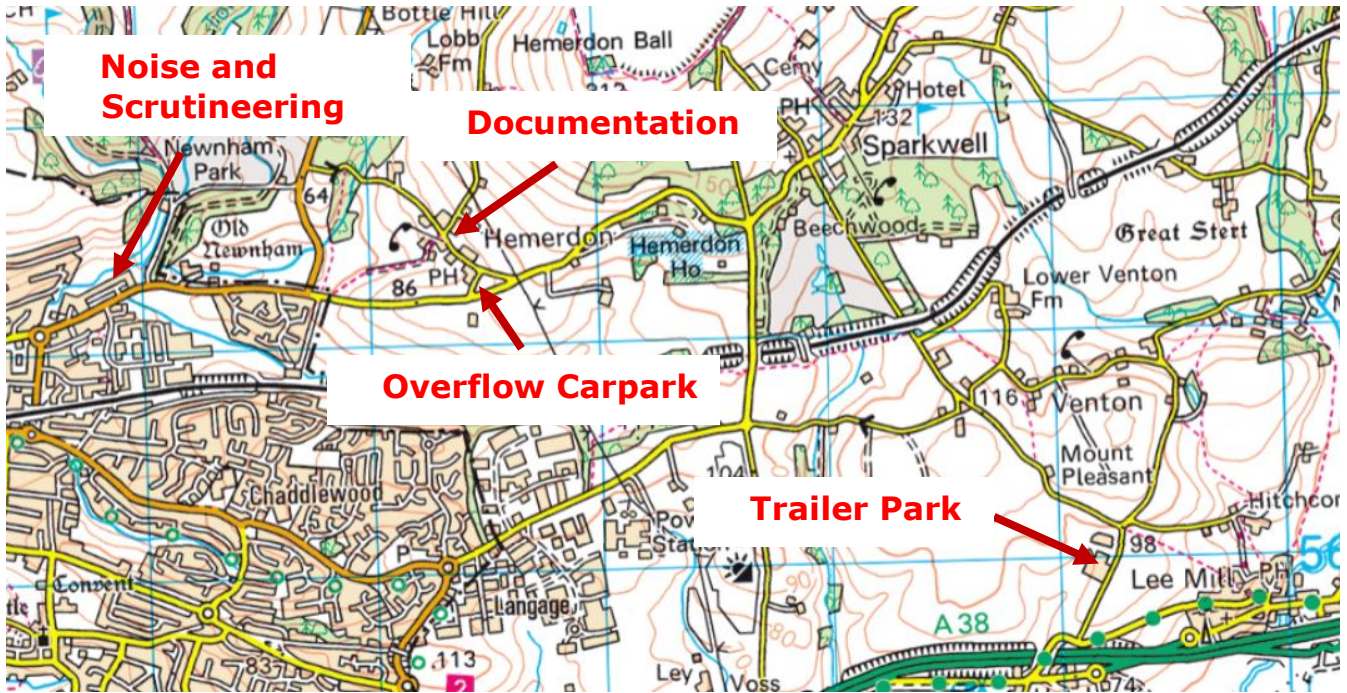

18. Results

Ch 13 App 5 Art 10.18 - The $\frac{3}{4}$ rule will not apply and competitors can only make time up at MTCs or Controls specified in the Route Instructions and/or Time Card.

In the event of a tie, Ch 13 App 5 Art 11.8 will be used Furthest Cleanest, and if that doesn't suffice, then the crew with the Smaller Engine CC will be placed higher.
